

ABSTRACT and Case Report FAQs

Submitting an Abstract or Case Report

Where do I submit an abstract/case reports for WAC 2024?	Please submit your abstract or case report here
When do Abstract/Case Report submissions close?	The abstract submission deadline has been extended to 30 June
Where do I include the Background Information and Case Presentation in the submission form if I am submitted a Case Report?	For the purposes of submitting your case report, please include the Background Information in the Introduction section and the Case Presentation in the Material/Methods section.
When will I be notified if my abstract/case report was accepted?	Notifications will be sent out in July
Are Encore Abstracts Allowed?	Encore Abstract submissions are only allowed if there has been significant updates since the first presentation
Does the submitter have to be a registered author?	A non-author may submit on behalf of the author(s). However, if the abstract is accepted, we will need the contact for the presenting author.

When do Late Breaking Abstract submission open?	15 July 2024
When do Late Breaking Abstract submission close?	15 August 2024

The Presenting Author

Does the presenter need to be an author?	Yes
Does the presenter have to be the first author?	No, it can be anyone who is a credited author. In the submission form please mark the (anticipated) presenting author with a *



Can the presenter be from industry? Yes, but only if they are a credited author

Is in-person attendance required for poster presentation? A presenter must register and attend the WAC regardless of presentation method

Can the presenting author act as a presenter for multiple abstracts? Yes, so long as they are a credited author.

Poster Presentations

Are digital poster presentations allowed? No; all poster presentations must be physically printed by and brought to the Exhibit Hall by the presenting author.

Is in-person attendance required for poster presentation? Yes, only for the presenting author

Can a non-author present a poster on behalf of the author(s)? No, the abstract must be presented by a credited author

Will congress allow to change the presenter at a later stage if designated author cannot present due to any reason? Yes, so long as the replacement presenter is a credited author of the abstract and is registered for the WAC

When are posters due? The presenting author must print their own poster and bring it to the Exhibit Hall. This date will be communicated to the presenting author.

Will posters be published after the WAC? No, but there will be a PDF posted with the abstract details on the WAO website.

Are QR codes permitted on posters? Yes, but they are not required.



Registration

When should the presenting author register for the WAC?

The presenting author should wait until they receive confirmation of their abstract acceptance before registering.

How will the presenting author receive the early-bird pricing?

When they are notified of their abstract acceptance, they will receive a special registration discount code. They will need to register themselves on our [website](#).

Is there a deadline for author registration?

The final deadline for the presenting author to register is not yet confirmed. It will be late July or early August

Are there any awards for travel grants?

Unfortunately, not at this time
